- 1. The *Pitfalls* sermon discussed 4 different pitfalls or ditches into which we often tend to fall if we're not careful: the wrong motives, the wrong instruction, the wrong influence and the wrong attitude. With which of these do you identify most and why?
- 2. The wrong motives can lead to our destruction. Read and reflect on the following passages:
 - I. Psalm 7
 - II. James 1:13-15
 - III. Galatians 6:1-10
- 3. How do you think we can check our motives and our hearts?
- 4. The wrong instruction leads us to walking in the dark, rather than living in the light. Read Proverbs 4:1-19 and reflect on how you can practically put this passage into practice in your life?

- 5. The wrong instruction is often linked to the wrong influences, which can also lead us to pitfalls (See Luke 6:39). What are you allowing to influence your thinking and decision making at present? Are there any influences you should be guarding against?
- 6. How do you think you can ensure that God's Word and Truth are the primary influence in your life?
- 7. The final pitfall we discussed was the pitfall associated with the wrong attitude, particularly, pride.

 Read and discuss what you take from the following passages:
 - I. Proverbs 16:16-19
 - II. James 4:1-6
 - III. 1 Peter 5:1-7
- 8. How do you think we can actively cultivate humility and dependence on God in our lives?
- 9. How do you think we can make sure we avoid the pitfall of wounded pride that results in offence, especially in the church?
- 10. What will you practically take from this session?
